CORRIGENDUM

This is in reference to the RFP for **Development of Municipal Solid Waste Sanitary Landfill Project for Shimla on Design, Finance, Build Operate and Transfer (DFBOT) Basis** uploaded on the MC website on 18-03-2013 and written queries received as well as discussions in the pre-bid meeting held on 10-04-2013 the following clarifications are made:

General: The clause (f) 9.1.2 Financial Offer should be read as “MCS is offering a financial assistance to the project in the form of capital grant of Rs 9.39 Crores. The first installment shall be Rs 2.10 Crores. The tranche shall also be proportional to the ratio of the grant amount and the actual project cost. The funds shall be released after due certification and proof of utilization of such funds.

Viz: If the ratio of Project cost to Grant amount is X%, then the tranche amount released will be X% of the value of actual work implemented and certified. The Grant shall be treated as advance payment and shall be secured by an Bank guarantee for the like amount. The bank guarantee shall be released after the Defects liability period of Three years”

Prospective bidders should note that the total grant of Rs. 9.39 crores should be utilised within Jan 31, 2014, failing which the unutilized grant would lapse. No enhancement in tipping fee would be allowed by MCS in such an event.

2	As per RFP Vol. 1, Page No. 34, Appendix 1.10 Adjustment to the tipping fee, point 2 Adjustment on quantity of inerts actually landfilled, Minimum guaranteed waste at SLF is 15MTD; whereas in Vol. 2, Section 2.2. Sanitary landfill the capacity of the landfill has been calculated considering 20 MTD inerts. Kindly confirm the minimum guaranteed waste, whether 15 MTD or 20 MTD?	As per the tender, 15 MTD is the minimum guaranteed waste averaged over one calendar month and 20 MTD is for design of SLF.
3	Does the contractor needs to set up a processing or segregation facility for the biodegradable waste or plastics received?	Not foreseen
4	How much Construction and Demolition waste is expected to be received at the SLF per annum? Does the contractor required to process it before landfilling?	Not foreseen
