SCHEDULE-A

SITE OF THE WATER SUPPLY AND SEWERAGE SYSTEM

1 THE SITE

- **1.1** Site of the Water Supply and Sewerage System shall include the land, buildings, structures and road works as described in **Annex-I** of this **Schedule-A**.
- 1.2 The extent of the Service Area for drinking water and sewerage services in as described in Annex II of this Schedule-A
- 1.3 An inventory of the Site including the land, buildings, structures, road works, trees and any other immovable property on or attached to the Site shall be prepared by the Authority Representative and such inventory is described as **Annex-III** of this **Schedule-A**.
- **1.4** Additional land required for construction of works specified in Change of Scope Order shall be acquired in accordance with the provisions of this Agreement. Upon acquisition, such land shall form part of the Site and vest in the Authority.

Annex – I (Schedule-A) Project Site

1.1 The Site

The water supply and sewerage system aims at improving the existing water supply and sewerage services in the city of Shimla. Thus the construction package for the project includes upgradation of the existing and development of new project facilities to as to attain 24X7 water supply and sewerage services in the city of Shimla is defined as "Water Supply and Sewerage System".
